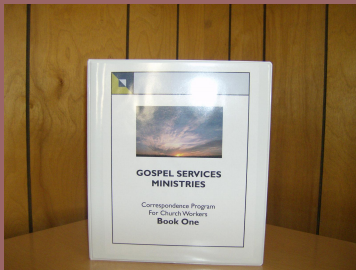


GSM SERVICES
